Thank you for your interest in volunteering in the Quality Control area of the Tarrant Area Food Bank. We appreciate and depend on our volunteers! *In 2007 volunteers provided more than 60,000 hours of work.* Our 69,000 square foot warehouse is a very busy so we must adhere to strict policies in order to ensure the safety of our employees and visitors.

Safety Guidelines for Quality Control Volunteers

- Volunteers must be **at least 16 years old** to box food in the warehouse. (The only exception is our Backpack Program on Wednesday evenings. Call or e-mail for more information about this program.)
- All youth groups must have adult supervision.
- Group size is limited to no more than 30 volunteers unless prior arrangements have been made.
- Sandals and open-toe shoes are **not** allowed. Shoes must be closed-toe and cover the entire foot. **No exceptions.**
- Wear clean, comfortable, appropriate clothes. Short shorts, half shirts that bare the midriff and low cut tops may not be worn. Clothing and jewelry should not be loose or dangling.

Our address is 2600 Cullen Street, Fort Worth 76107. We are located three blocks east of University Drive and two blocks north of White Settlement Drive at the corner of North Vacek Street and Cullen Street. Enter through the east door on North Vacek Street and continue through the double doors. The sign-in area is on the right. The Quality Control area is straight ahead. The staff will meet you there.
